It was wonderful to see so many families at the Open House. We are so excited to welcome all the students to John Paul II on Wednesday, August 19. The school looks wonderful, the teachers and staff are all ready, so let the learning begin! Let's have an awesome 2015-16 school year.

Now that the computer lab, teacher laptops, and Promethean Boards are updated to best serve our students, we know we have a missing link in our technology at John Paul II. We are one of a small percentage of schools that does not offer the use of iPads. At this time we are asking you to prayerfully consider giving a donation to make the purchase of iPads possible for our students. The approximate cost of one iPad is \$599. We would like to purchase 25 iPads, 25 iPad cases, and a charging cart making the total project worth \$16,069. We have already been blessed with over \$3,000 in donations. Thank you to the families that have already donated. If you are able to make a donation, please send it to the school in an envelope marked "iPads" or turn any donations directly into the school office. If you are not able to make a monetary donation, we ask that you pray for the success of this project.
