Dear Parish Family,

Staffing at Holy Family: If you were not able to be with us last Sunday, then you missed the opportunity to meet our new Youth Director, Briana Fiegen. She spoke at all the Masses introducing herself to the parish, and asking for your help in our outreach to Grades 7-12. I am delighted to welcome her at Holy Family and Holy Spirit. Nigel McBain, continues to settle in here at Holy Family. I am very grateful for his efforts. Nigel has also been meeting with Catholic Faculty and Staff at DWU to start a new outreach there, as well as being present to the students at MTI. Sr. Joyce Feterl, OSB, will be joining us next month to begin coordinating the outreach to the homebound and sick of the parish. I thank Sr. Nancy Dywer for her past service. Sr. Joyce has been serving as a Chaplain at Queen of Peace Hospital, and is a Salem SD native. **New Hymnals:** The current hymnals are out of date, with the translation changes that went into effect Advent of 2011. Further, many have been "retired" from service because they have fallen apart. This Advent we will switching to the *St. Michael's Hymnal*. More information will be forthcoming, but you will be invited to contribute and memorialize each copy. **Building Updates:** The old rectory, has been razed, and work continues to remove the rubble. Regrettably there was a water line from Langdon street that was found to be active; so they will need to dig up the street and to cap it off. The tuck-pointing continues on the Church, and ARS (Architectural Roofing Services) out of Sioux Falls, along with Puetz Corp, hope to be done with the significant repairs on the flashing of the roof. If after the fall weather it proves to have succeeded in preventing water intrusion (aka water leaking) then the interior work will be restored. Further, the carpet and flooring of the Sanctuary needs to be addressed, along with the steps going in to the Altar Area. Lastly, J F. Nordlie Organ Company has been consulting on repairing and restoring the Church's Pipe Organ. More as things develop! Lastly, let me again thank you for your continued generosity in supporting your Parish of Holy Family! All that we do, is for God's glory, and to make his Son Jesus known.
