



# Nineteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time



August 7, 2016

## The Texts at Mass – The Ordinary and The Proper

Whether you've been attending Mass all your life, or you've just come into the Church, you'll probably be very aware that, week by week, some texts we say or sing stay the same and some change. This gives the Mass its inherent characteristics of both unchanging stability and constant variation. Perhaps less well known, however, are the terms the Church uses for what texts change or stay the same at Mass.

The texts that *don't* change, like the **Kyrie**, **Gloria**, the **Creed**, the **Sanctus** (*The Holy, Holy Holy*), and the **Agnus Dei** (*Lamb of God*), are collectively called, **The Ordinary of the Mass**. "Ordinary" in this context doesn't mean "average", instead it means something more like "regular" or "usual". Some of these texts are omitted at weekday Masses or in penitential seasons, such as Advent or Lent. When the parts of the Ordinary are omitted, however, nothing replaces them.

All the texts of the Ordinary are based on Scripture and the official teachings of the Church. In fact, it is quite a task to chase up all the Biblical allusions the Ordinary contains. Even a seemingly simple text such as the priest's greeting of the People with the words, "The Lord be with you." resonates in many places in Scripture, not least among which is the Angel Gabriel's salutation to Mary, "Hail, full of grace, the Lord is with you!" from Luke 1:28.

On the other hand, the texts that *do* change, such as the **Entrance Antiphon** (or **Introit**), the **Responsorial Psalm** (or the **Tract** in the Extraordinary Form of the Mass), the **Alleluia** verse, the **Offertory Antiphon**, the **Communion Antiphon**, are collectively called, **The Proper of the Mass**. "Proper" used like this doesn't mean "correct" or even "formal", but instead is used to signify something closer to its Latin derivation from the preposition, *prope*, meaning, "close to" or "near". In other words, the Proper of the Mass, is the collection of texts which are associated closely with a particular day's celebration, e.g. The Eighth Sunday in Ordinary Time.

**The Propers** (the various texts of the Proper), like the parts of the Ordinary, are usually based on Biblical texts, Psalm verses, or other poetry, that set out the themes the Church is highlighting on any given day. For example, the Entrance Antiphon of The Mass of the Ascension begins, "*Men of Galilee, why are you gazing in astonishment at the sky?...?*", which is taken from Acts 1:11, recalling the amazement of the Apostles at the Lord being taken up into heaven.

About five times a year, the Proper includes very special additional texts called **Sequences**, sung before the Alleluia, which are longer poems associated with a particular celebration, such as the sequence, *Stabat Mater*, sung on the Memoria of Our Lady of Sorrows (September 15).

So, look out for how the words of the Mass either change or remain the same in different times and seasons. Listen to how the Proper Antiphons set out the themes of the Mass. The texts are very beautiful and have been set down for us by Holy Mother Church, in her wisdom, for our edification. The Ordinary and Propers (except for the Offertory Antiphon) can be found in the Seasonal Missalette. Make them part of your preparation before Mass and they will help your active participation in the celebration.
