

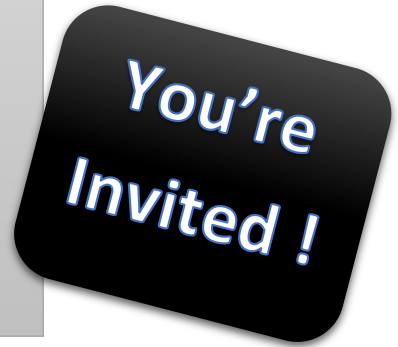

In a concerted effort to pool our resources of volunteers and donors, the decision was made to consolidate the Autumn Classic and the Development Dinner in to one NEW event. For ease in donor solicitations, sponsorship opportunities are connected to the Golf Scramble in June.

**Bids for Kids** will be held on **Friday, May 6, 2016** at the **Highland Conference Center**.

Happy Hour will begin at 5:30 with free hors d'oeuvres and a free keg. Billy Lurken will be entertaining us with live music during happy hour. A cash bar will also be available.

During this time, you will also have the opportunity to purchase chances for the Wine Pull, Heads or Tails, Deck of Cards, Whistle Blower games and bid on the Dessert Auction.

**Wine Pull** = \$20 per chance. Choose a numbered cork. Once all the corks are sold, match your cork to the bottle and see if you are a winner of a \$100 bill! The drawing will take place as soon as all corks are sold. Wine donated by National Republic Wine Distributing.

**Heads or Tails** = Purchase as many sets of \$20 beads as you wish. This game will be played during the live auction portion of the evening. Participants choose "Heads" or "Tails". A coin is flipped. If you chose the correct answer, you stay in the game. If you purchase multiple chances, you continue to play until all your chances are gone.

**Deck of Cards** = Red Deck is \$20 a card, Black Deck is \$50 a card. Choose your card. Once all cards are sold from the deck, the winning card will be drawn. Winner of the red deck wins \$500 cash. Winner of the black deck wins \$1000 cash!

**Whistle Blower** = \$100 raffle tickets will be sold in advance and up until the start of the live auction. Immediately before the live auction starts, the winning ticket will be drawn. The winner will reveal themselves to the auctioneer and choose any one of the Live Auction Items of their choice. The auctioneer will give the winner "The Whistle". The auctioneer will be the only person to know which live auction item the winner chose. When the item they chose comes up for auction, the winner will blow "The Whistle" to stop the auction. The winner must be present, or have a designated person present to choose their item immediately.

**Dessert Auction** = Silent auction format to win your tables dessert for the evening, or to take home for later! Auction begins at 5:30pm and ends at 6:30pm as dinner is served. Winners will be announced and the dessert will be delivered to their table.
