Dear Parish Family,

After much evaluation, and with best and prudent repairs in mind, today I received word from Bishop Swain to proceed with the recommended and needed repairs. After visual and physical inspection of the roof; many areas of the flashing show deterioration and failure. This includes two of the shorter towers at the west entrance and at the north and south transepts. Regrettably when the current roof was installed; it was installed over the old roof. It would appear that much if not all of the original flashing was kept.

These flashings will need to be replaced, so that it can more effectively move water away from the roof. In addition, extensive holes in the grout have been found that need to be repaired, and then significant chemical waterproofing. In addition to this we must be committed to regular, ongoing observation and maintenance for effective and long term care of this historic Holy Family Church for the generations to come!

Normally, I would have preferred to meet in person with our Parish Council and Finance Council before going forward, however time is pressing. Every time it rains, water intrudes the building with potentially causing further damage. After the repairs are made, and after an appropriate amount of time has passed the plaster will be repaired, and painting of the interior will take place. The estimated cost for these repairs is \$140,000. I am asking you to be generous in using your Yellow Envelopes to support this effort. More as information comes.
