This past week Pope Francis released his much anticipated encyclical letter on the environment, named "Laudato Si" after the first line in St. Franics of Assisi's Canticle of the Sun. The encyclical letter builds on previous Catholic social teaching in regards to human beings' relationship with

There is a beautiful prayer at the end of the encyclical which I would like to share with you:

Pour out upon us the power of your love, that we may protect life and beauty. Fill us with peace, that we may live as brothers and sisters, harming no one. O God of the poor, help us to rescue the abandoned and forgotten of this earth, so precious in your eyes. Bring healing to our lives, that we may protect the world and not prey on it, that we may sow beauty, not pollution and destruction. Touch the hearts of those who look only for gain at the expense of the poor and the earth. Teach us to discover the worth of each thing, to be filled with awe and contemplation, to recognize that we are profoundly united with every creature as we journey towards your infinite light. We thank you for being with us each day. Encourage us, we pray, in our struggle for justice, love and peace. Amen.
