New Parish Outreach Minister

I am S. Joyce Feterl, a Benedictine sister from Yankton, SD. Although I have just begun my ministry here at Holy Family Parish three weeks ago, I have a long history in the diocese of Sioux Falls. I was born and reared on a farm near Salem, SD. I was educated by the Benedictine sisters in Salem and again at Mount Marty College. (Yes, you do have two MMC graduates on staff!) Entering Sacred Heart Monastery during my senior year in college, I began my novitiate year after graduation and made vows in 1975.

Most of my ministry years have been spent in Catholic education. My career started as an elementary physical education teacher and later after receiving my MBA, I worked in the Sioux Falls Catholic School business office and at Mount Marty College in the Student Affairs office. Recently, you may have met me at Queen of Peace hospital where I served as a chaplain for the past two and a half years.

As Benedictines sisters, we strive to live the model St. Benedict left us in his Holy Rule for living. In Chapter 36, he states, "Before all things and above all things, care must be taken of the sick, so that they will be served as if they were Christ in person." And Jesus himself said "I was sick, and you visited Me," and "What you did for one of these least ones you did for Me." Powerful stuff!

So my focus as the Outreach minister is to make contact with those parishioners who are homebound, sick, or unable to be active in the life of the parish. I hope to serve as a bridge between them and the parish to provide prayer, conversation and bring communion to them. They are still very important and treasured members of our parish and the Body of Christ. I am happy to serve as the new Outreach minister and it is a joy meeting and visiting with many new friends.
